

Startup Internship Program 2017 FAQ's for Student Applicants

What is the Startup Internship Program?

Thanks to a grant from the Coleman Foundation, the Coleman Entrepreneurship Center will be sponsoring student internships this summer at local Chicago startups. Students will be selected based on an [online application](#) now open.

Students must also be available for interviews on Friday, March 10, at the Coleman Entrepreneurship Center offices (DePaul Center, 1 E Jackson Blvd, Suite 7900).

Who is eligible to apply?

All current DePaul students are welcome to apply.

How do I apply?

Is this a paid internship? When will I be compensated?

Yes, this is a paid internship. Student interns will be paid \$12/hour for a total of 125 hours during the summer. Students will receive two payment stipends of \$750 each, one in the middle of the internship and upon completion of the required hours. The total paid to students for the summer internship program is \$1,500.

How long is the internship?

The internship must take place between June 20 and August 25. Internship schedules and other arrangements should be worked out between the student and individual startups.

How are selected applicants matched with startup organizations?

Selected from a pool of student applicants, the most qualified students will be matched to a startup by Coleman Center staff after the interview process.
