FAQs for Startup Organizations

What is the Startup Internship Program?

The Coleman Entrepreneurship Center will be sponsoring ten student internships this summer at local Chicago startups for 125 hours.

Who is eligible to apply?

Startups must be a legally established entity, 5 years old or younger, and have received less than \$1,000,000 in outside funding.

How does my company apply?

How long is the internship?

Registered startups should keep in mind that student interns would be required to work a total of 125 hours over the course of the summer. All work for the internship must be completed between June 11 and August 19, 2018.

How are selected organizations and student interns matched?

Selected from a pool of student applicants, the ten most qualified **students will choose the startups** they want to work for over the summer. The matching process will be held in the Coleman Entrepreneurship Center on March 30, 2018.

What type of work should interns do?

These internships are designed to be experiential learning opportunities for students and a chance to see first-hand the challenges that startups face. Interns should have significant tasks that contribute to the success of the organization. In the past, interns have done market research, created web content, developed marketing and sales strategies, and helped to redesign website functionality.
